# ABBYY FineReader PDF Chest Agreement

- Agreement runs from 1 August 2023 – 31 July 2026
- Institutions can sign up at any time for a 3-year site licence
- Site licence covers installation on all institutionally-owned computers and access from personal computers via virtualisation technologies. Overseas use is also included
- Covers both ABBYY FineReader PDF Corporate for Windows and ABBYY FineReader for Mac licences
- Use by staff and students for teaching and learning, research, and administration

# What is FineReader PDF?

ABBYY FineReader is a PDF tool that empowers information workers to manage any kind of document in the modern digital workplace.

Powered by ABBYY's AI-based OCR technology, FineReader PDF makes it easy to digitize, retrieve, edit, protect, share, and collaborate on both digital documents and paper-based ones.

# Document-Related Problems? – FineReader PDF has a solution!

## PROBLEM

---

- **Hours** are spent on **editing or updating PDFs** without the original digital file
- Need to protect sensitive information due to **security concerns** and **compliance requirements**
- **Keeping up** with **changes** in the **latest** version of a document can be difficult
- **Paper** documents are easily **misplaced** or **lost**, and many PDFs are **non-searchable** (i.e., scans)

## SOLUTION

---

- **Edit** and **organize PDFs** of **any kind** and **origin** in the **same efficient manner**
- Use **password encryption**, **redacting sensitive information**, or removing **metadata**
- Quickly and reliably **identify differences** between two versions of a document **across different formats**
- Document **digitization** for storage and quick and reliable **retrieval and access** to their content

# Campus (Site) Licence: Benefits and Features

Both FineReader PDF (Windows) and FineReader PDF for Mac are available with Campus licence

---

1. “Install and use”:
  - No centralized activation
  - No activation on individual devices
  - No logging in for users
2. No internet access is used by the software:
  - No information sent from or received by FineReader PDF
  - Service functions such as “Online help”, “Send feedback”, etc. are disabled
    - PDF with User Guide is available
3. Deployment (rollout) automation:
  - Distribution kit for Windows: .exe file. Standard deployment automation tools supported.
  - Distribution kit for Mac: .dmg or .pkg file. With .pkg, third-party deployment automation tools can be used.

# Campus (Site) Licence: Benefits and Features

Both FineReader PDF (Windows) and FineReader PDF for Mac are available with Campus licence

---

4. Use GPO to configure service functions of FineReader PDF on Windows (see in the [Administrator's Guide](#))
5. No built-in licence / user management tools
6. Access to the distribution kits must be restricted to IT staff only
7. FineReader PDF Campus distribution kits are **individual for each customer**
  - The licences are embedded into the distribution kits

# How to Deploy: Windows

Deploying FineReader PDF Campus (Windows) from your individual customized distribution kit is simple

---

1. The distribution kit should be unpacked into a shared folder.
2. Choose the installation method and follow the corresponding instructions in the [Administrator's Guide](#).

Notes:

- There's no Licence Server and Licence Manager in the distribution kit – they are not needed for Campus licence.
- The shared folder created on step 1 is used instead of Administration Installation point mentioned in the Administrator's Guide.

# Deployment Methods on Windows

## Command line (using setup.exe)

---

Supports:

- Silent installation
- Specifying UI language and a range of other parameters to configure FineReader PDF

## Using Windows Installer

---

Supports:

- Silent installation
- Specifying UI language
- Uninstalling in silent mode
- Repairing

## Active Directory

---

Supports:

- “Assign to Computer” installation method
- Using Group Policy to configure service functions of FineReader PDF

## Microsoft System Center Configuration Manager (SCCM)

---

Allows to specify:

- Computers for installation
- Time of installation
- Conditions for installation

**OS/disk cloning** is also possible.

# Deployment on Mac

FineReader PDF for Mac Campus is a separate product with a separate distribution kit. Possible deployment methods:

---

- Manual (interactive) installation on individual computers.
- Using an MDM solution of choice.

---

## **FineReader PDF 16 (Windows):**

- Microsoft® Windows® 11 / 10 (64-bit)
- Microsoft Windows Server 2022, 2019, 2016, 2012 R2 (including the use with Remote Desktop, RemoteApp and Remote Desktop Web Access)
- Citrix Workspace App 1808 (using installed application accessed from a server), Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops

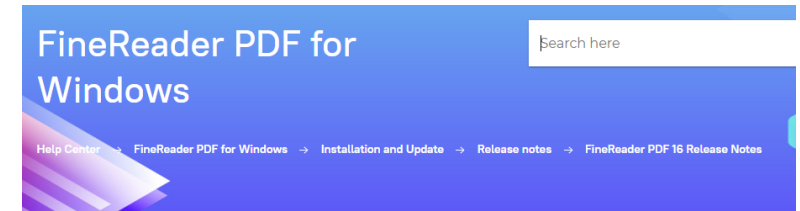
FineReader PDF updates deliver new and improved features, bugfixes, and compatibility.

  - Submit a request for the customized distribution kit to the [Support Team](#),
  - Install from the provided distribution kit onto the computers.
- With a service pack / patch (*for Windows only*):
  - Download the service pack / patch,
  - Apply to the existing installations as described in the instructions published in the Knowledge Base for each release (e.g., [the article](#) for the most recent release).

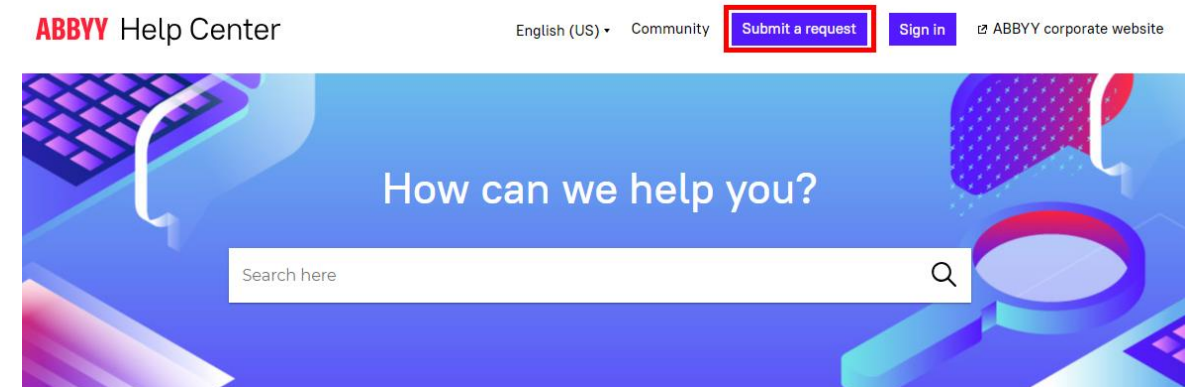
